What Does the Strength Mean?

The milligram number identifies the amount of oxycodone contained in a particular dosage unit. It does not indicate how much medication a person should take.

A higher strength is not necessarily a better choice for pain management. Opioid treatment is individualized, and increasing exposure can also increase the likelihood of serious adverse effects.

Do not self-adjust your medication. If your prescribed treatment does not adequately control your pain, speak with your healthcare professional rather than taking additional medication or changing to another strength.

Possible Side Effects

Oxycodone can cause several side effects. Some may be mild, while others can require urgent medical attention.

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- Nausea or vomiting
- Constipation
- Confusion or reduced alertness
- Low blood pressure
- Slow or difficult breathing

Medication and Substance Interactions

Oxycodone can interact with other medicines and substances. Combining opioids with alcohol, sedatives, or other central nervous system depressants can increase the risk of excessive sedation and dangerous breathing problems.

Dependence and Misuse

When to Speak With a Healthcare Professional
